### Author of Obama Election Diary to Speak at AWC

Documentarian, producer and author Sherry Hutson will speak at the July luncheon of the Association for Women in Communications (AWC) on Wednesday, July 18, at Biaggi's Ristorante Italiano, 1501 N. Veterans Parkway in Bloomington.

The author of *King's Dream: Barack Obama Becomes President of the United States of America, An Election Year Diary*, Hutson will explore the concept of translating an idea into a book. The self-published author co-wrote the book that offers a month-by-month chronology of the 2008 campaign featuring journalists, candidates, pollsters, pundits, bloggers, comedians, celebrities, musicians, artists, politicians and citizens.

Hutson, who recently retired as the director of web services and creative services at the University of Illinois-Springfield, was also the co-producer of a long-running jazz performance television program in the San Francisco Bay area. She also served as the manager of marketing and promotions for *Runner's World* magazine. Along with *King's Dream*, Hutson has authored two books about Adobe software and was a contributing editor for a multimedia textbook.
